Convocation Ceremony

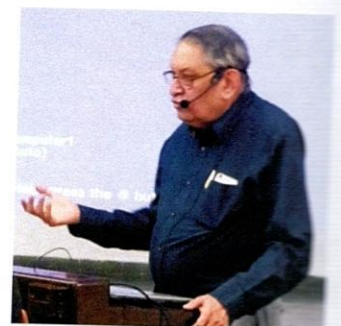

Session by WEF

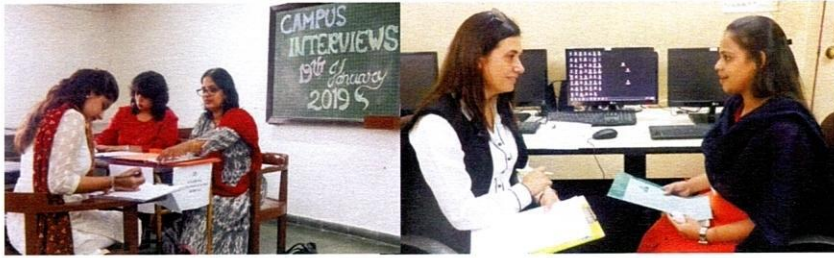

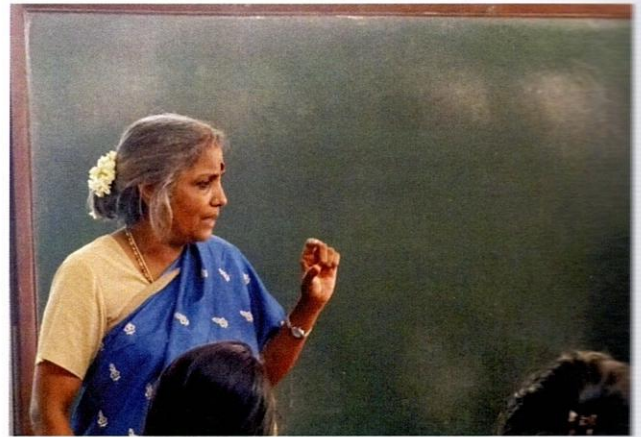

- Rendered their services to various NGOs namely, Tarun Mitra Mandal, Ashadan, Navjyot Foundation, ADAPT and many more



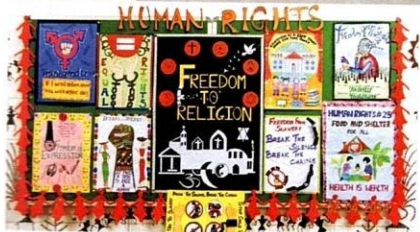
Student Council Activities
