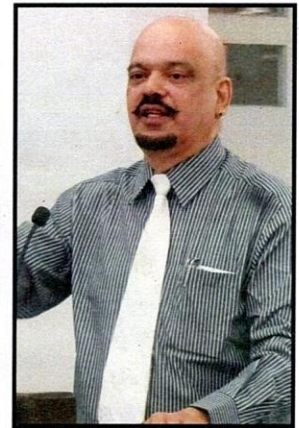

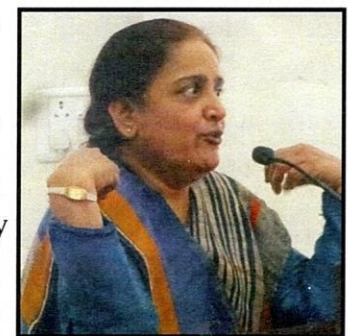

EPC Workshops

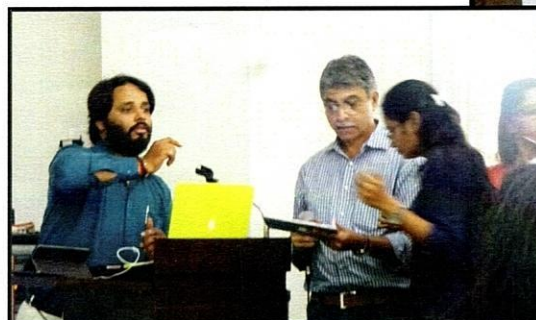

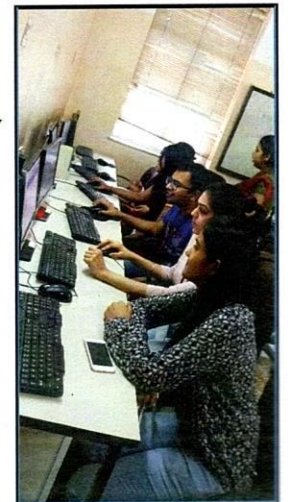
Care & Share

The students were provided opportunity to Develop life long skill, through self study sessions and develop communication skills through Language Lab



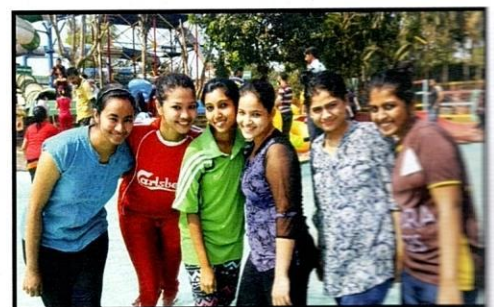
Constitution Day

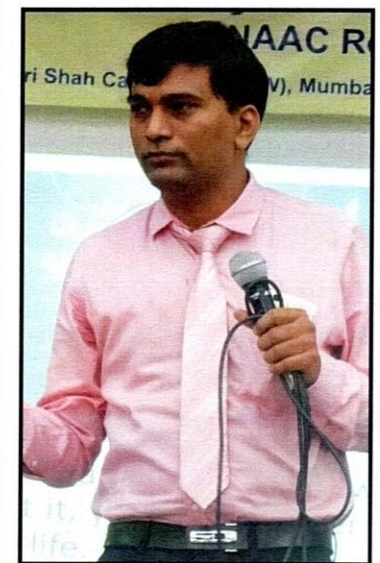
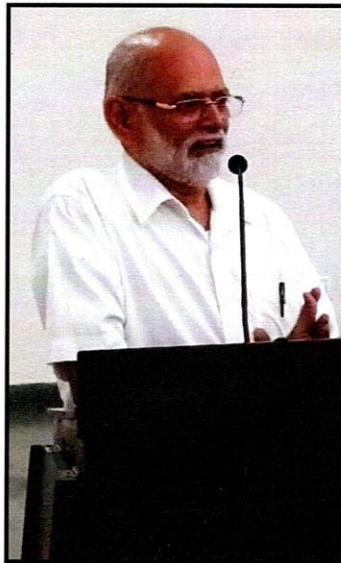

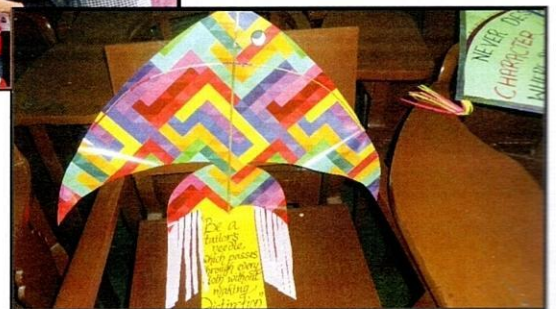

Intercollegiate Competitions

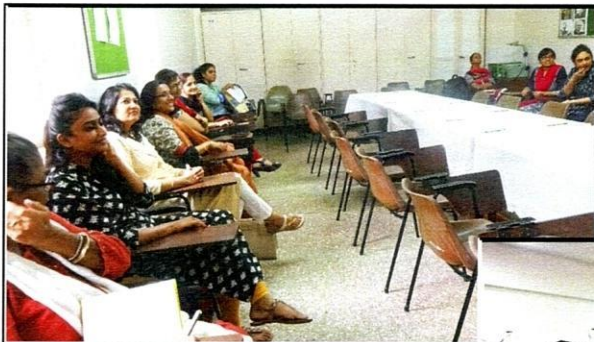
Students participated in various intercollegiate competitions and won accolades for themselves and the college.

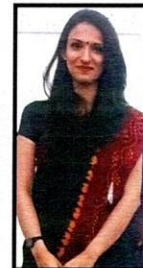

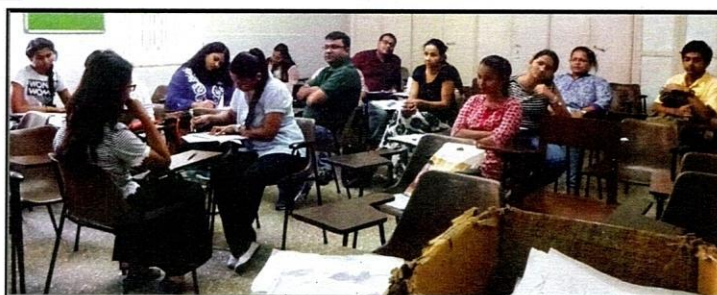
