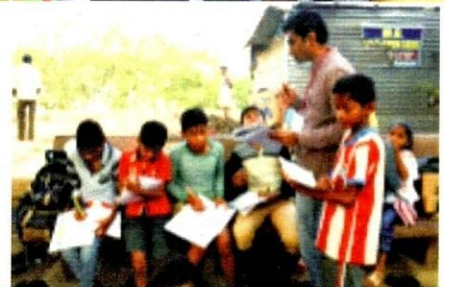

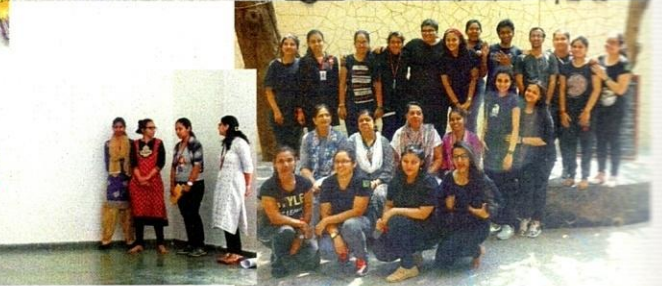
Special School- The sessions were conducted on How to use computers in the teaching - learning process for the students & the teachers.

B. Ed. Orientation

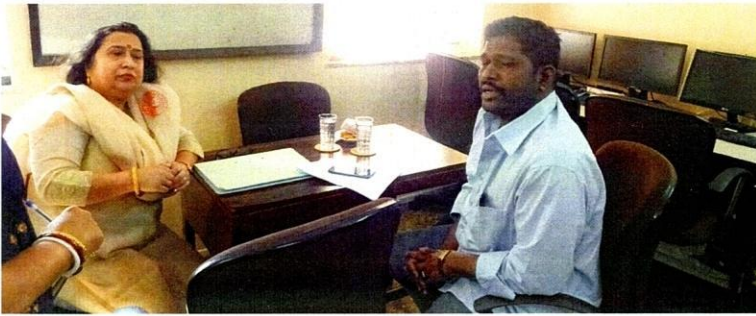


The orientation on ‘B.Ed admission process and CET’ organized for the prospective candidates. The students were oriented about CET examination, admission process and B.Ed. Programme.

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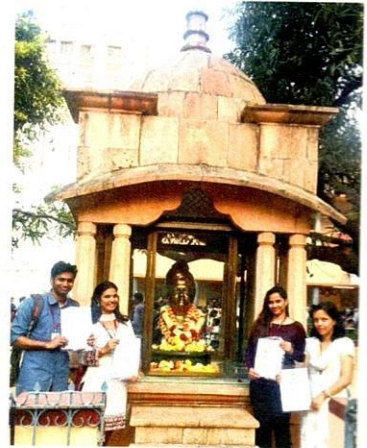
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Intercollegiate Competition
