The College received the honor of being a recognized **Vocational Education Nai Talim Experiential Learning (VENTEL).**



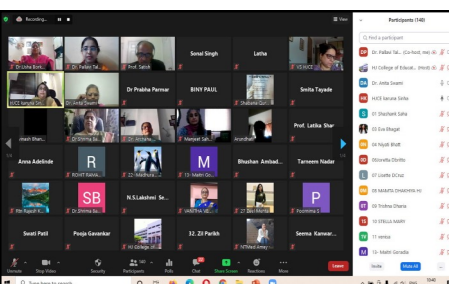

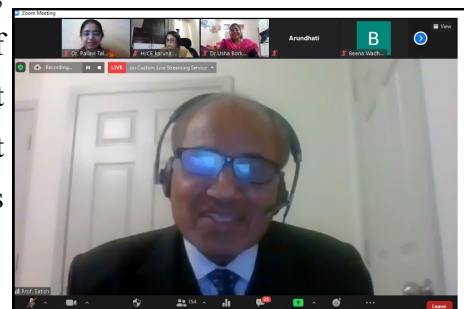
NATIONAL WEBINAR ON 'NATIONAL EDUCATIONAL POLICY 2020'

The college has organized one day National level online workshop on 'Emerging Trends in Artificial Intelligence' under the aegis of RUSA on 6 February, 2021. The resource persons

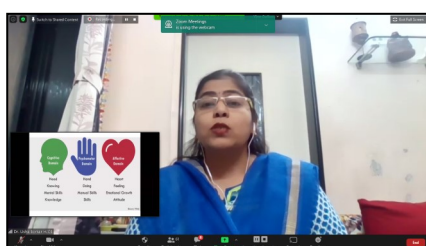
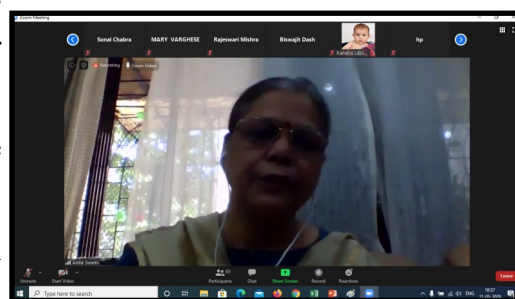

FDP ON ‘DESIGNING ASSESSMENT IN ONLINE AND BLENDED ENVIRONMENT’

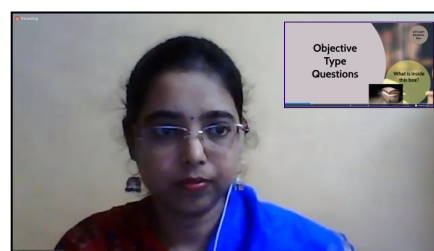

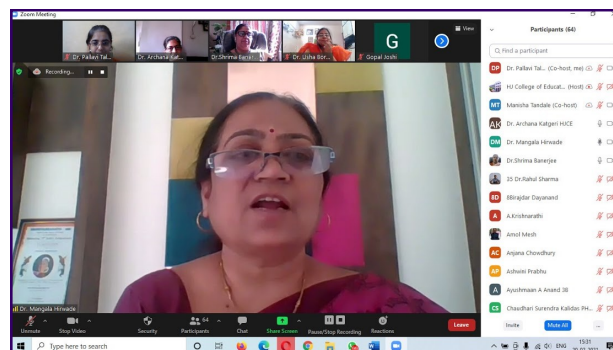
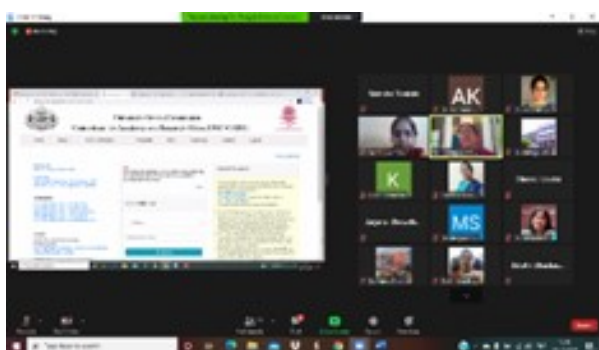
NATIONAL WEBINAR ON 'REACH THE STARS'

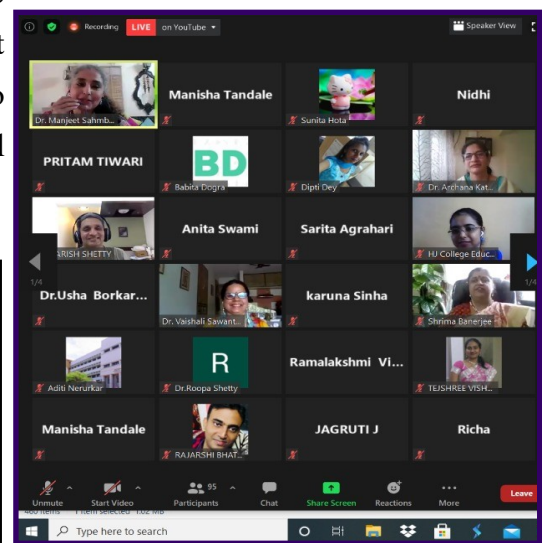
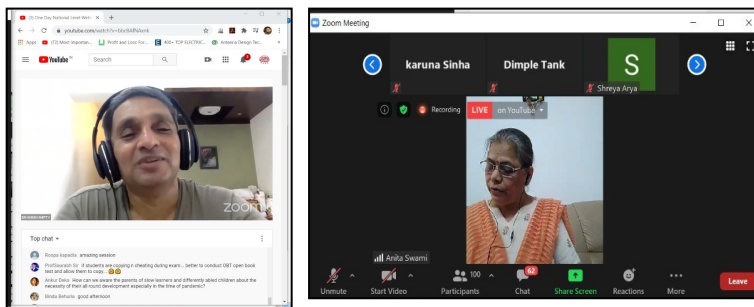
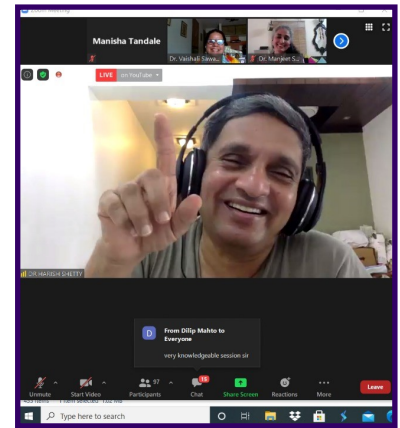
NATIONAL WEBINAR ON 'ACCOUNTABILITY OF THE RESEARCH PRODUCTIVITY'

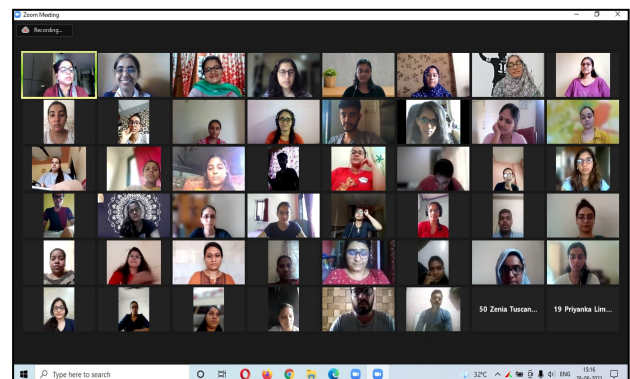
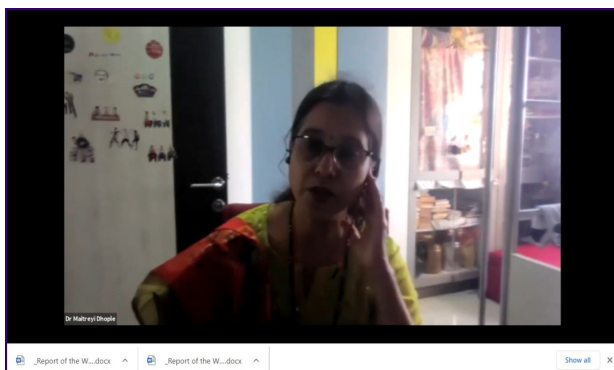
NATIONAL WEBINAR ON 'TEACHERS' WELL BEING AND ITS IMPACT ON STUDENTS' WELL BEING'

National workshop was organized on 9th March 2021 with an objective to create awareness among the youth about how addiction can change and jeopardize a person's life academically, financially and socially. The speaker

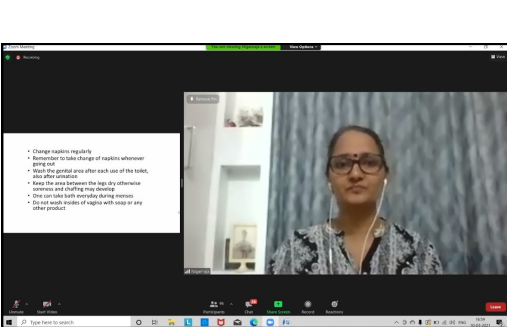

National workshop on 'De-Addiction and its Effects on Women's Health'

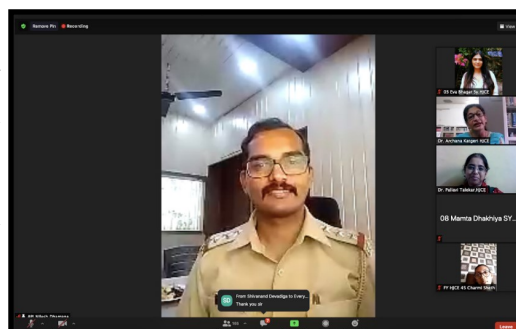

National webinar on 'De-Addiction and Role of Youth'

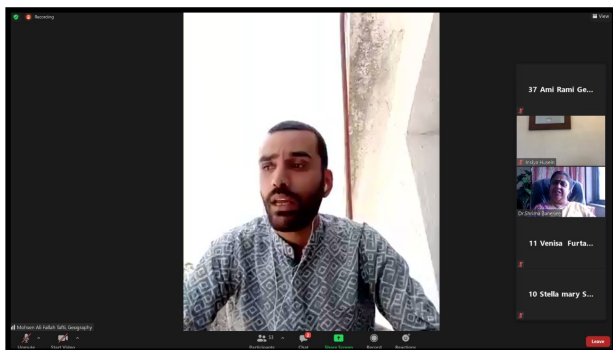
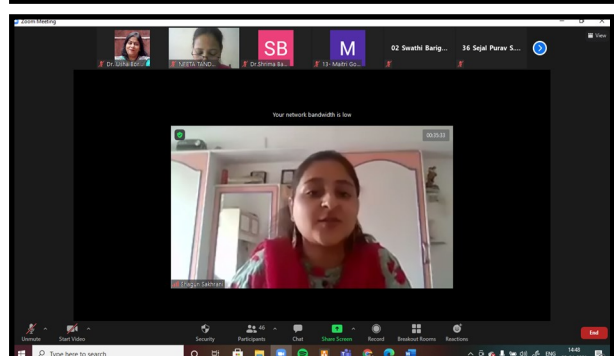
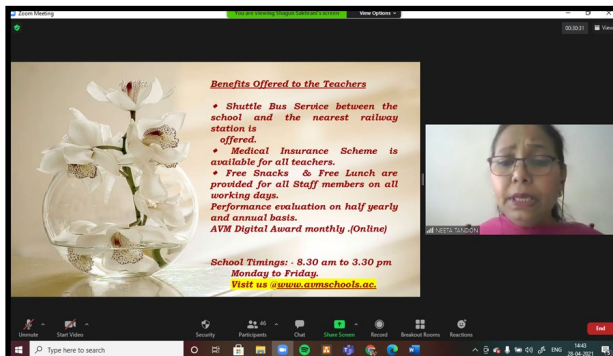
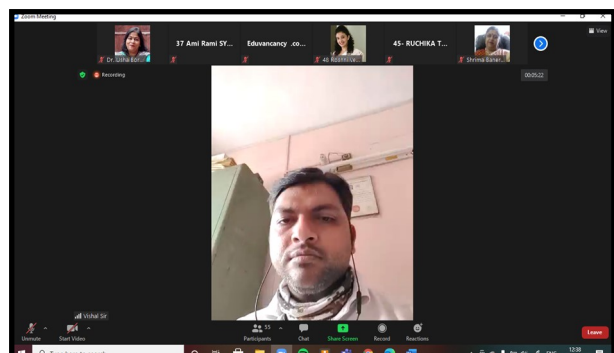
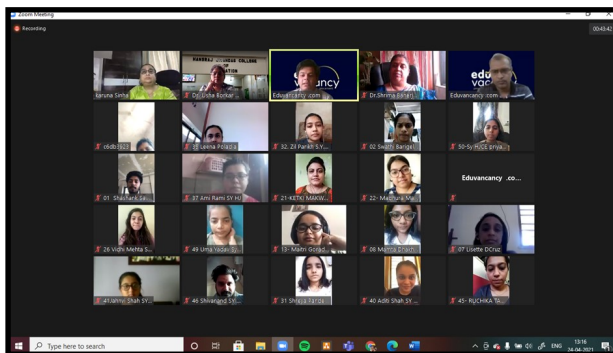
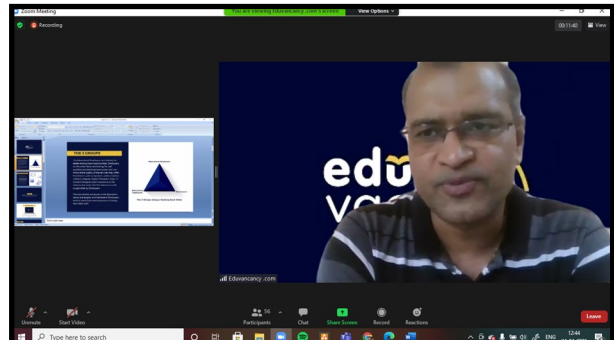
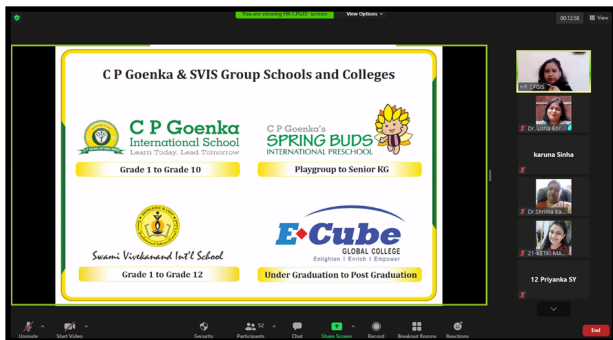

CYBER SAKHI PROGRAMME

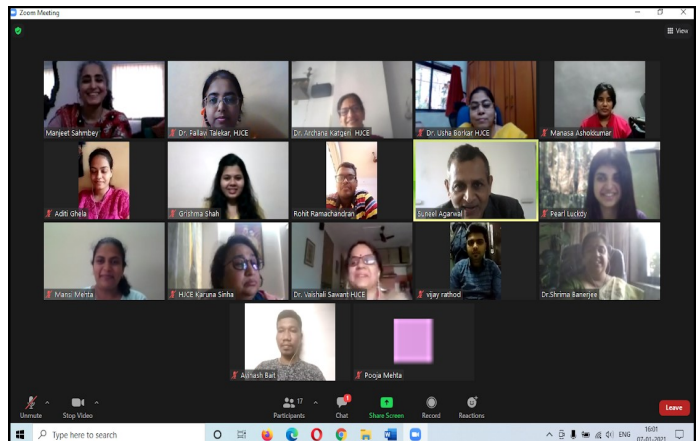

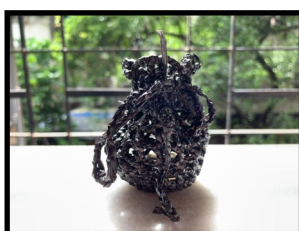


ACHIEVEMENTS AT INTER COLLEGIATE COMPETITIONS

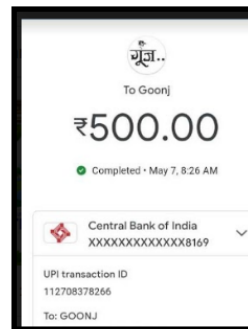
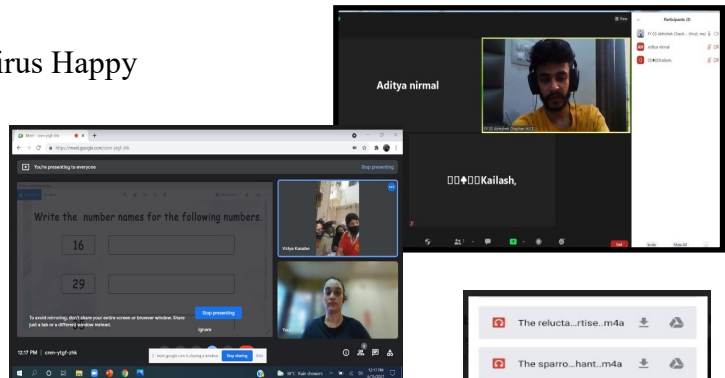
TOUCHING LIVES OF THE UNPRIVILEGED

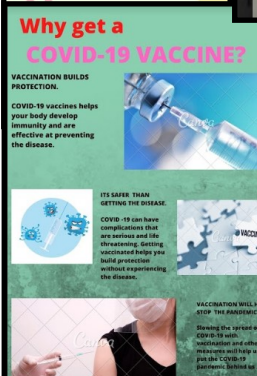
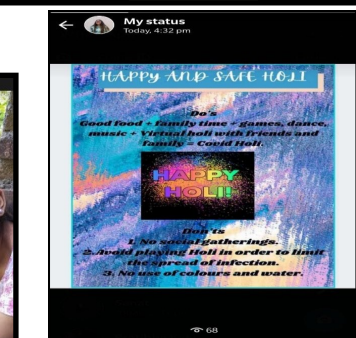
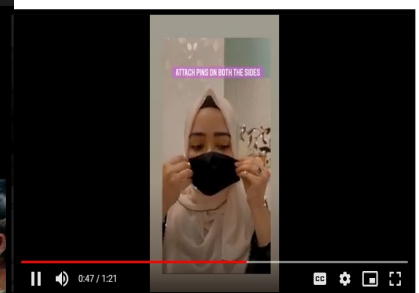
TOUCHING LIVES OF THE UNPRIVILEGED

Awareness Drive:

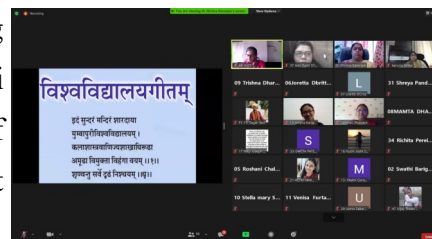

Mr. Agraj Sharma, Marketing Consultant took session ‘Management Skills’

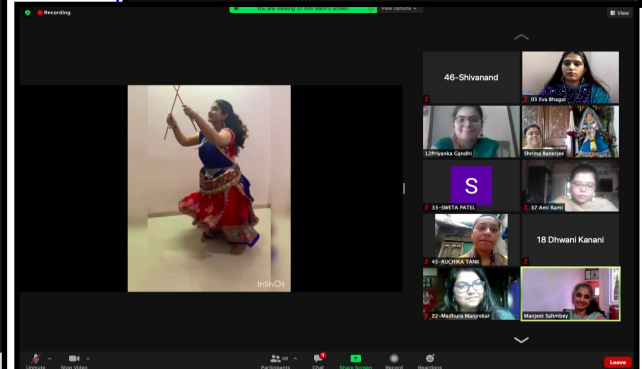
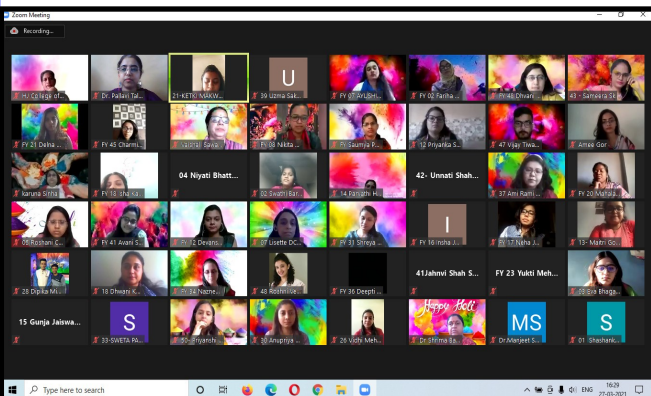
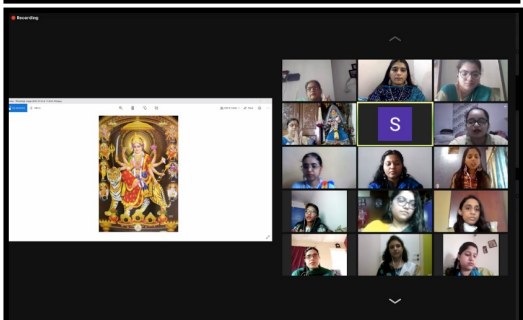
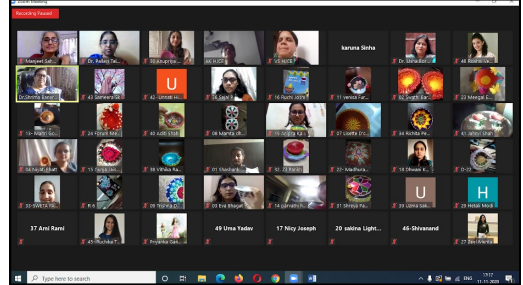
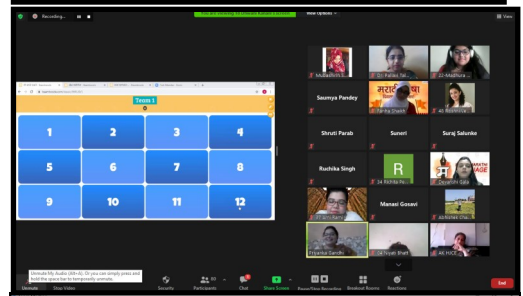
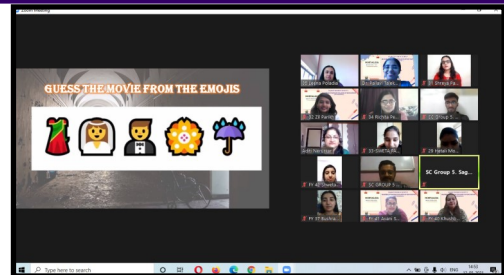
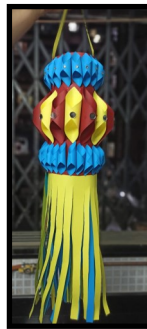
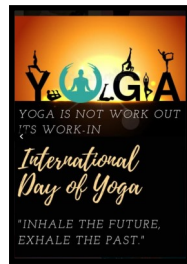

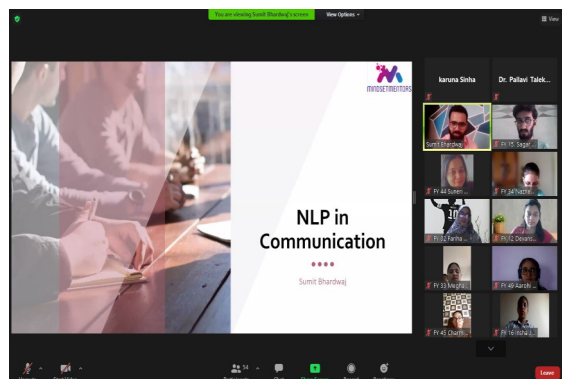
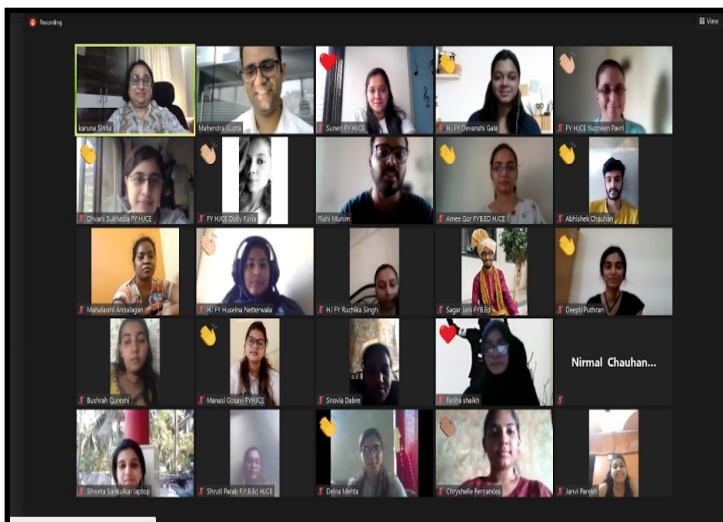
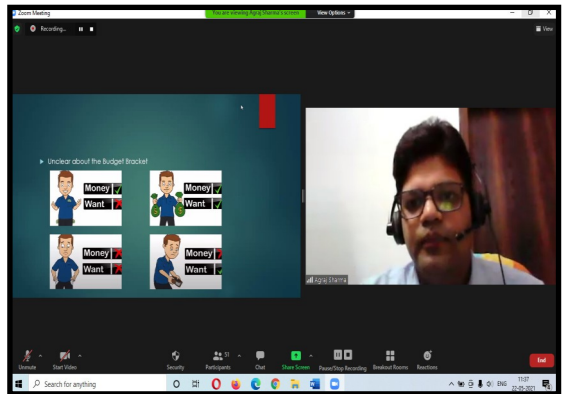
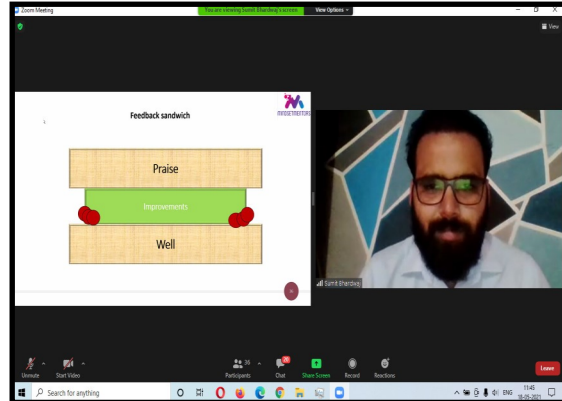
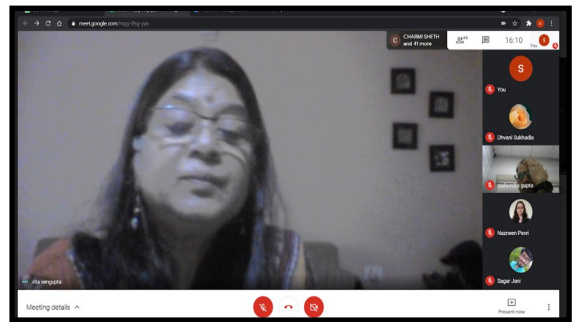
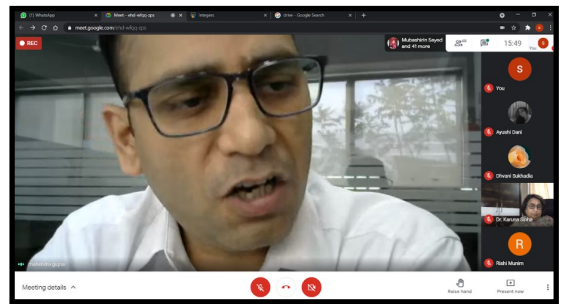
SPEAK WELL CLUB
