FACULTY INDUCTION PROGRAMME

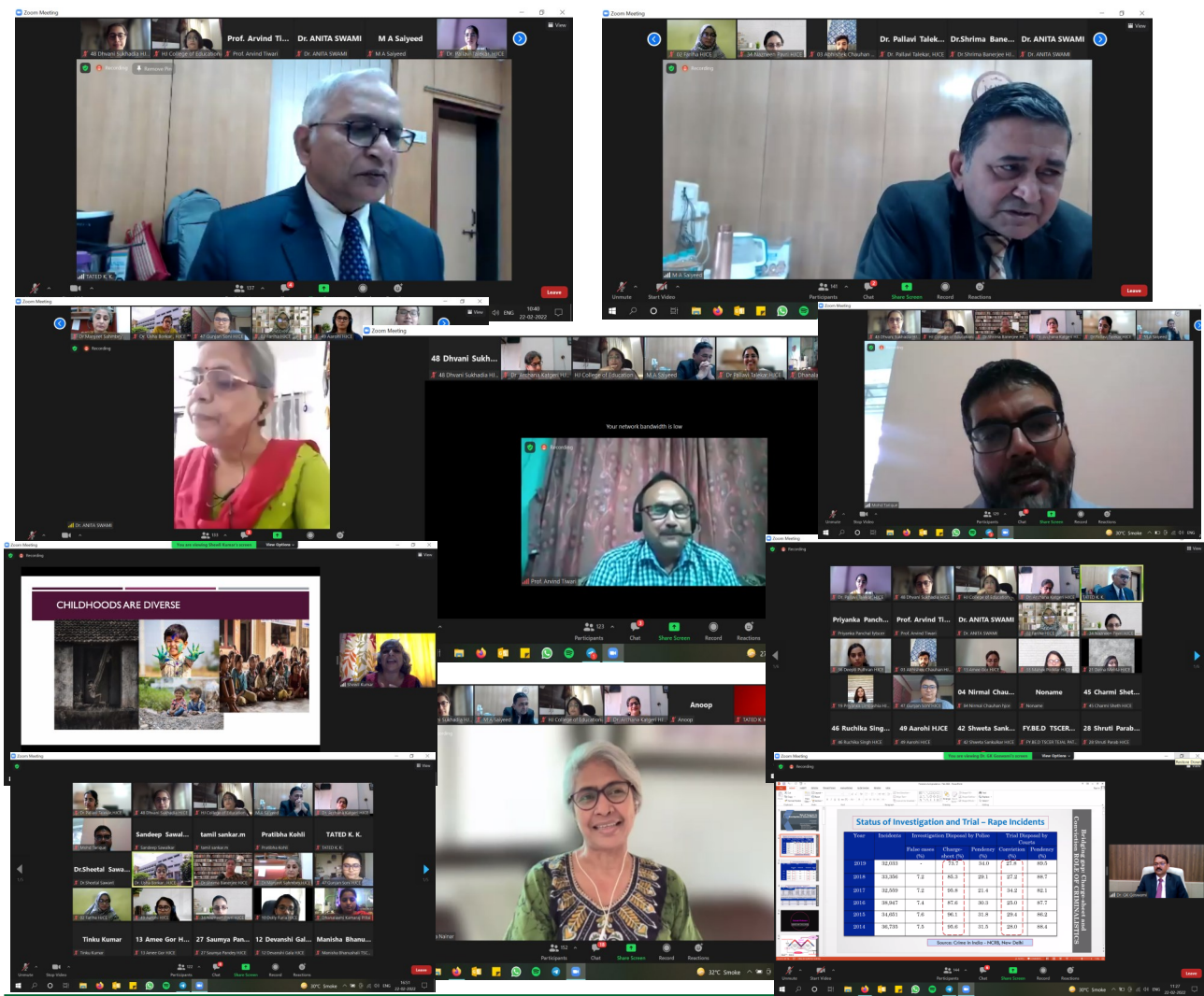

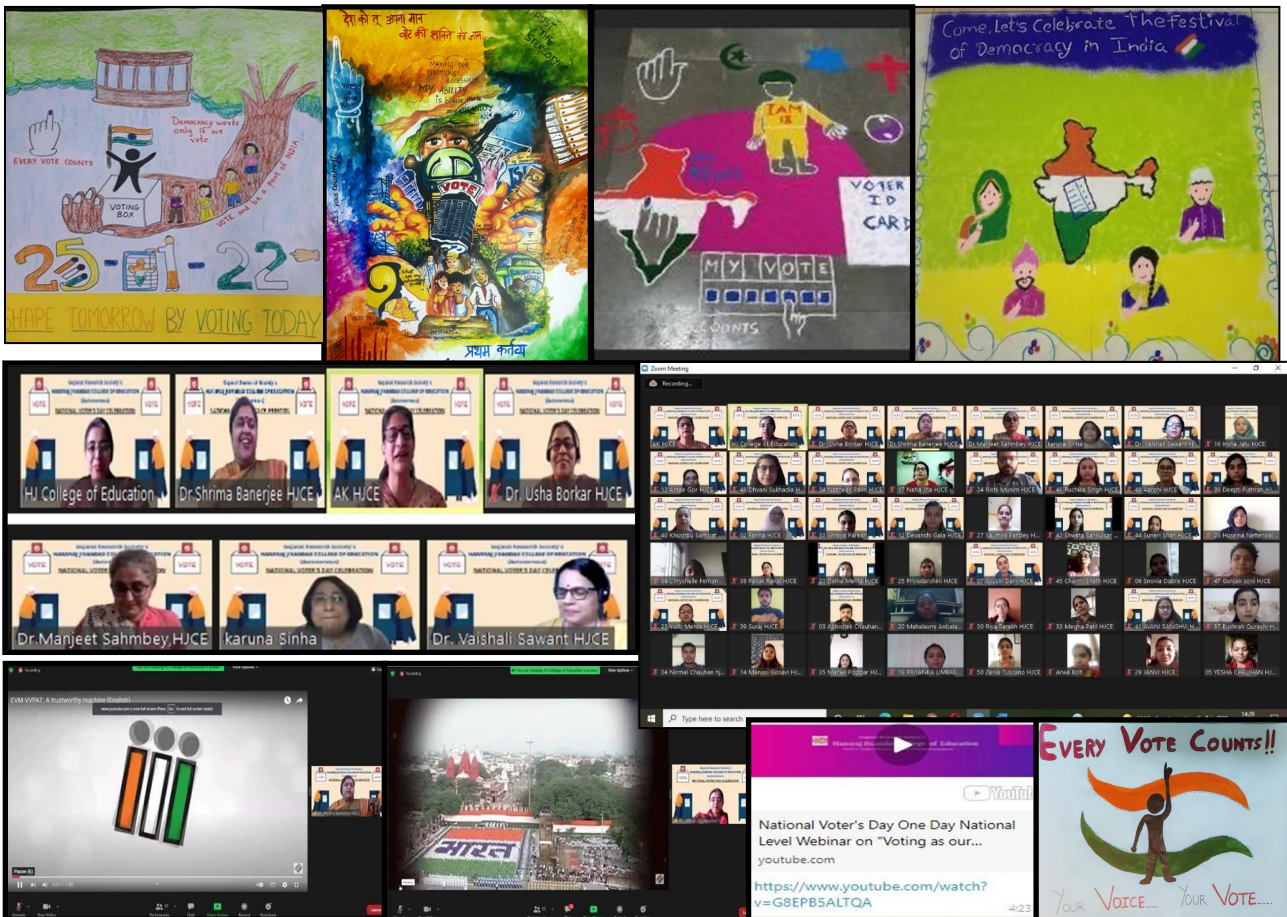


NATIONAL VOTER'S DAY

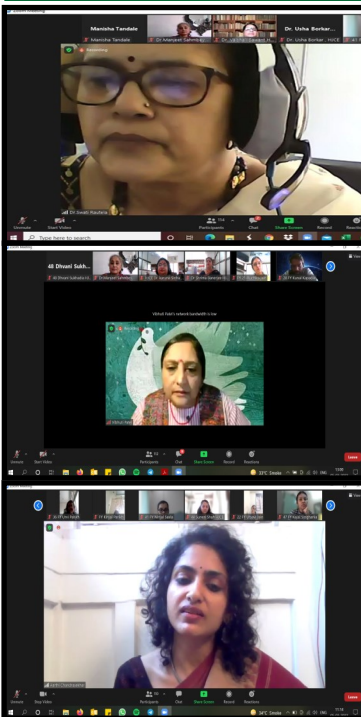

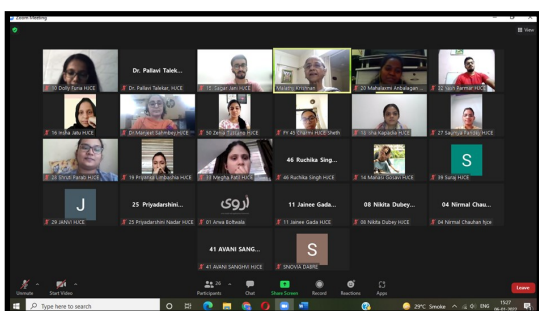
The Entrepreneurship, Employability and Career Hub under RUSA conducted the following programmes:

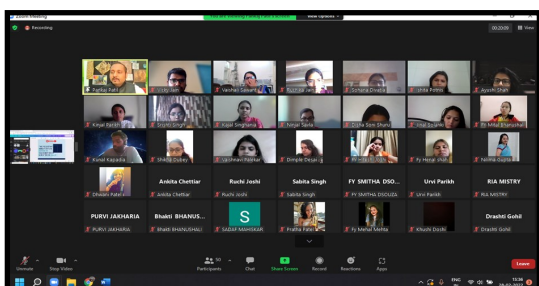
Certificate Course in Python Programming for Data Analytics was organized in collaboration with Develearn, Mumbai from 10 January to 5 April 2022. Mr. Akshay Kadam and Ms. Prajakta Kulkarni were the resource persons. Students learnt how to use the Python for coding and essentially web designing by providing students hands on experience, home assignments to practice and an online test at the culmination of the programme to award them a certificate.

Session on Use of Canva in Teaching and Learning was conducted by Mr. Pankaj Patil on 28 February 2022.



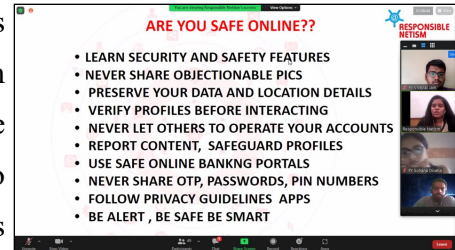
EXPERT TALKS

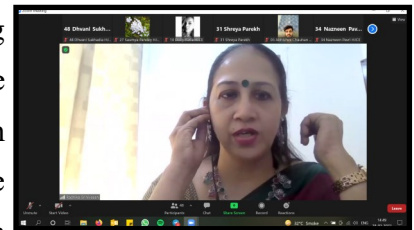


on prevention of online distress is the key to ensuring young girls and women leading

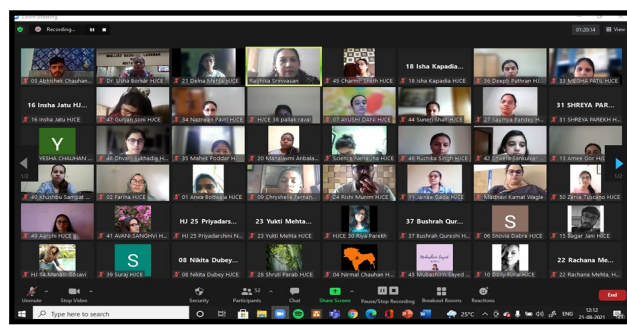
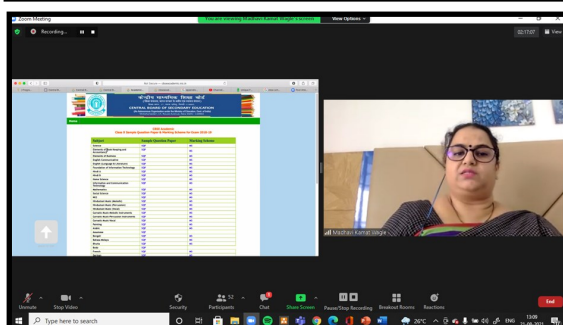
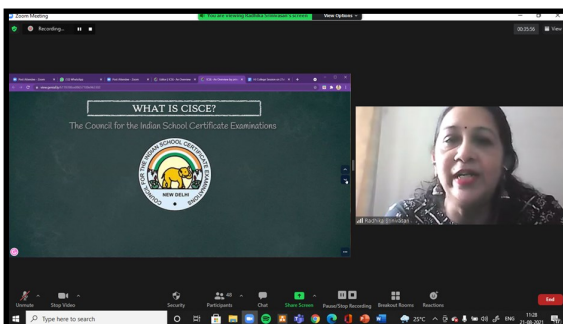

different boards the following talks were organized.

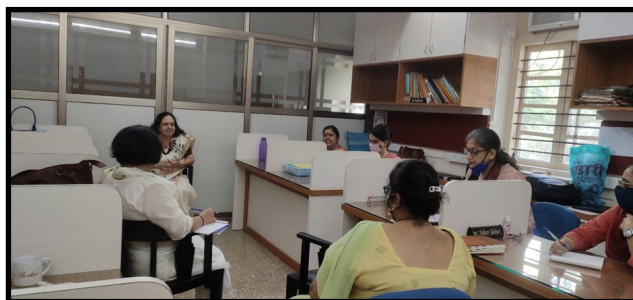

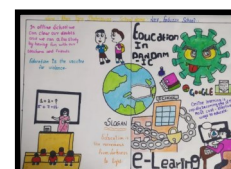
SMT. KALLOLINI HAZARAT MEMORIAL CREATIVE MIND FEST 2022

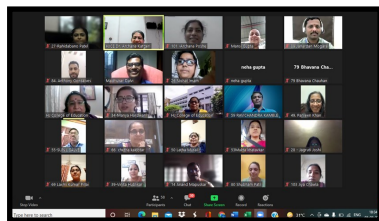
RESEARCH CELL

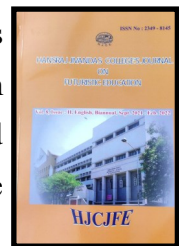
The Research Centre of the college organized various activities for its registered Ph.D.Scholars and faculty of the college which are as follows:

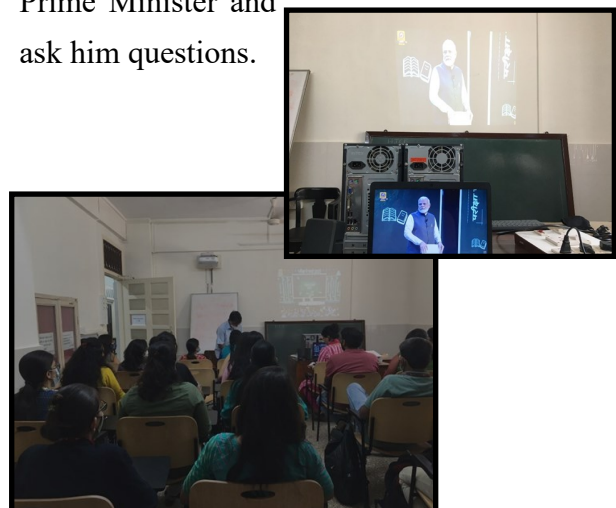

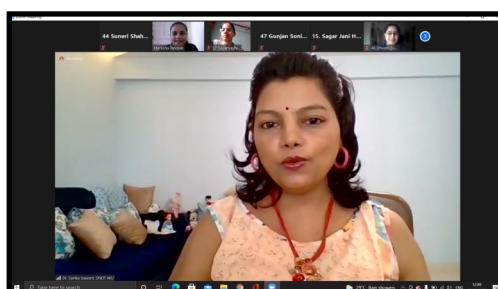
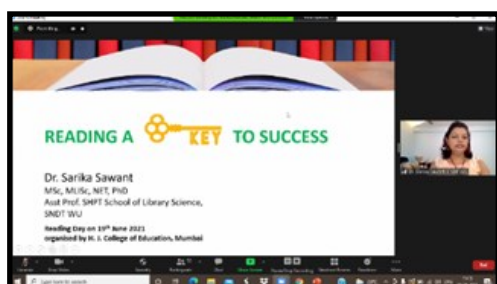
LIBRARY ACTIVITIES

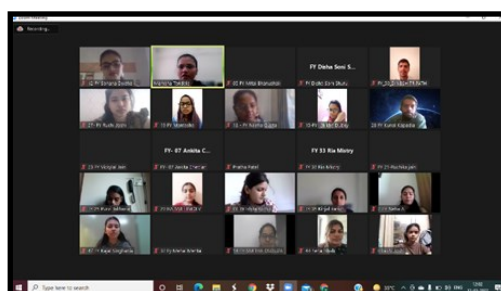
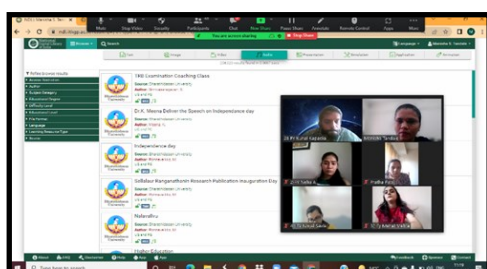
The college library has organized various activities:

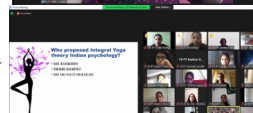
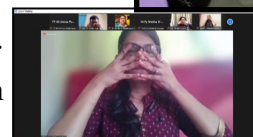
The various activities organized by the college on the occasion of International Day of Yoga 2022 are as follows:

APY Stalls: DLLE Department of HJCE has organized APY stalls with focus on satvic food.

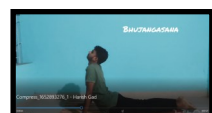
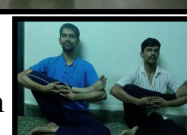


‘Yoga: Art of Living’ session was organized to train students to perform yogasanas.

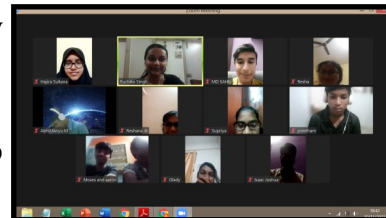

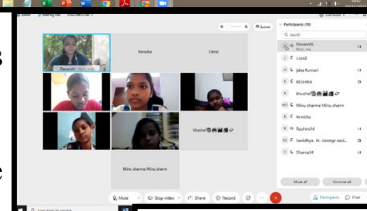

✓ All Virus And No Work..... Makes A Virus Happy: Prepared the worksheets of Mathematics and Science for children ranging from grade 3 to grade 8

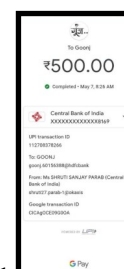

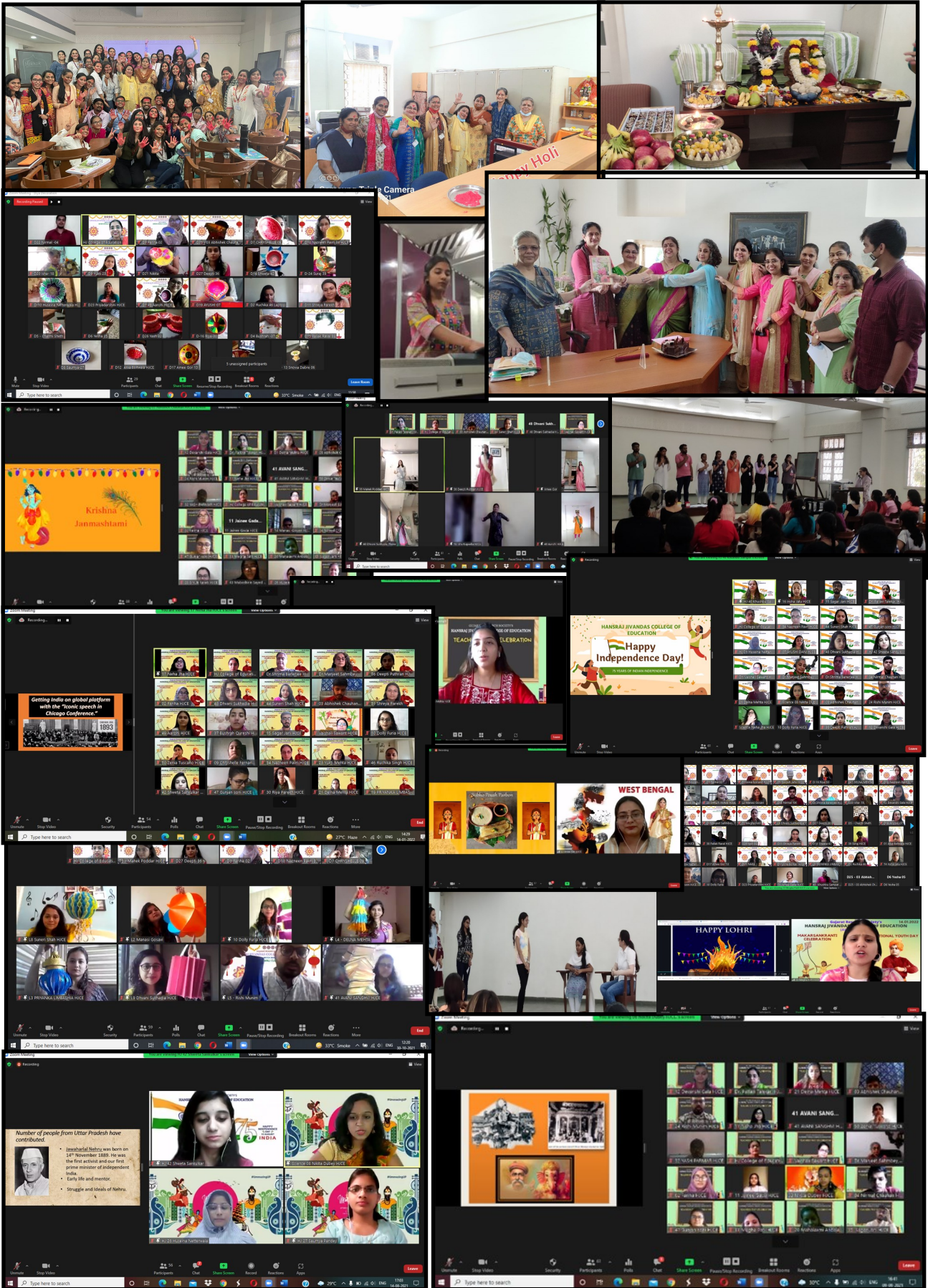
STUDENT COUNCIL

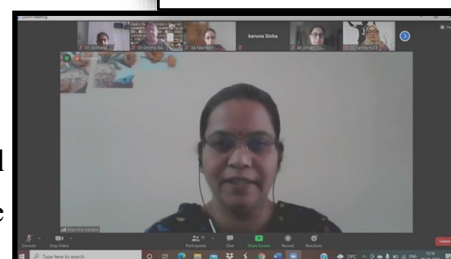

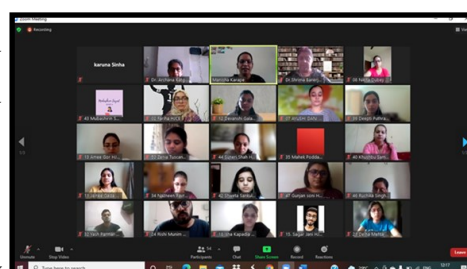
Online Workshop:

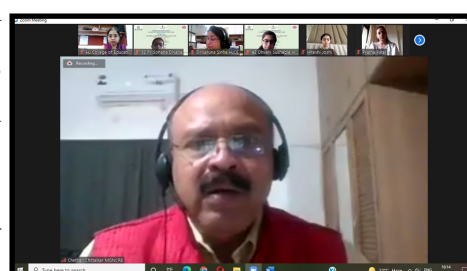
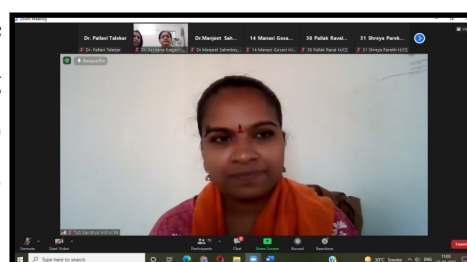
Webinars:

WOMEN DEVELOPMENT CELL ACTIVITIES

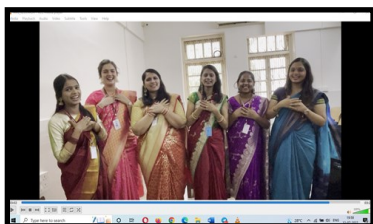

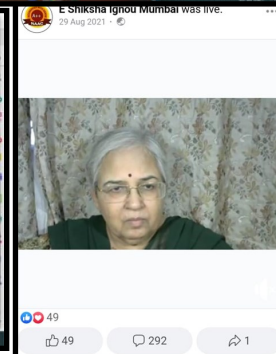
SHIV SWARAJYA DIN

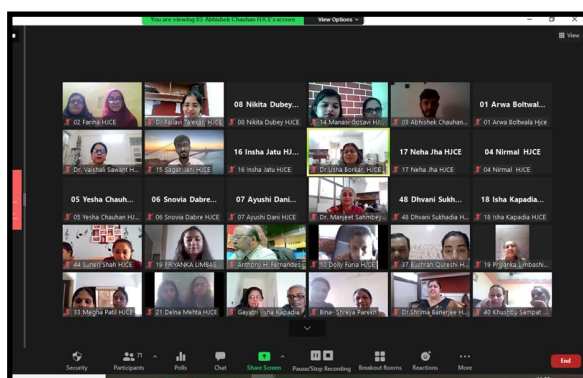
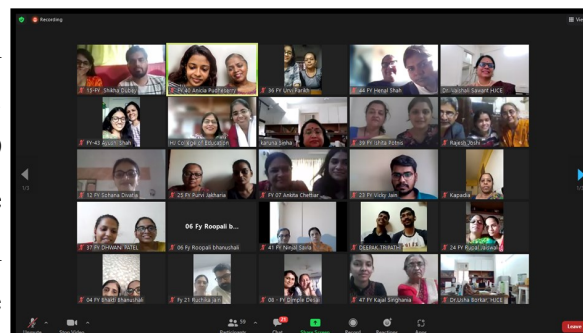


PTA MEETING

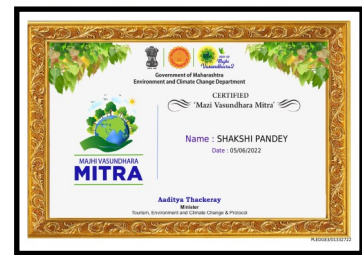


ENVIRONMENT CLUB

The students took an E-Pledge on Energy Conservation, participated in Tree Plantation and shared Seed Saplings with the community as part of the Environment Club activities.

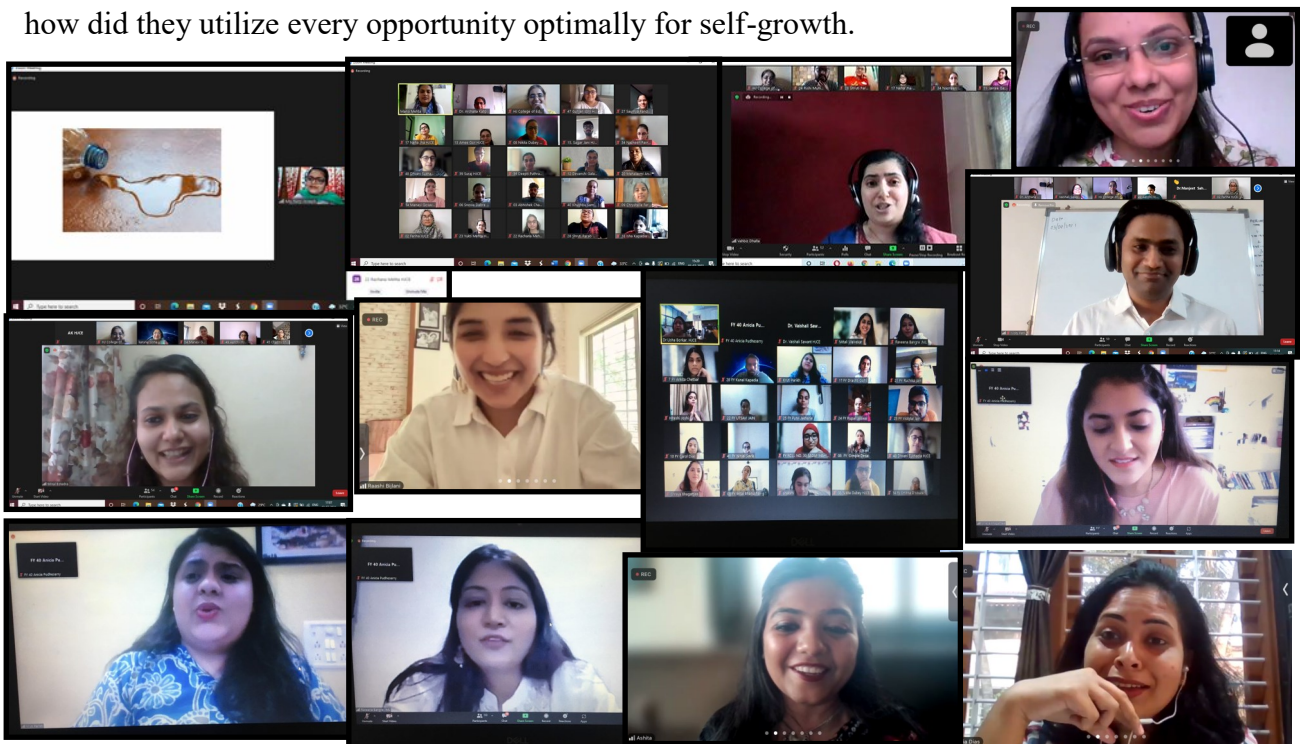


HJ ALUMNI ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES

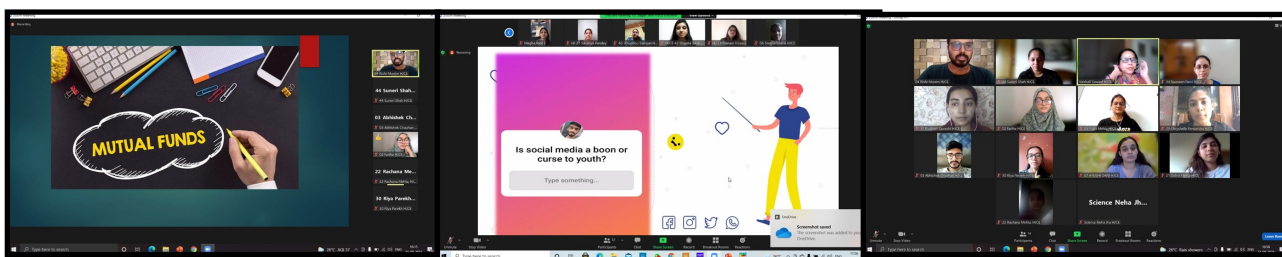
CAREER KATTA

The college has organized a program to celebrate Marathi Bhasha Divas on 28th February, 2022. The following activities were organized on this occasion:

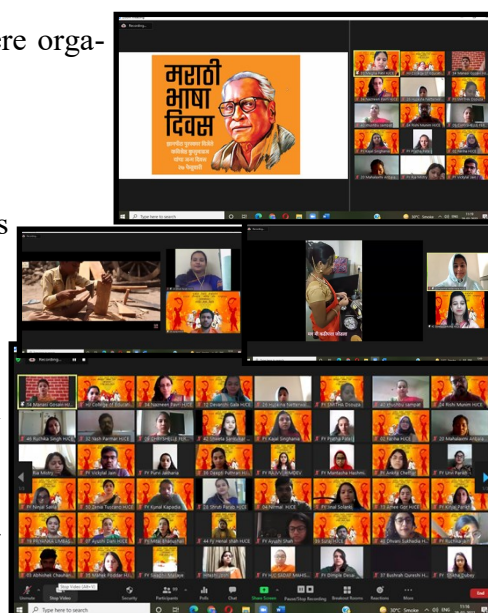

Science Club:

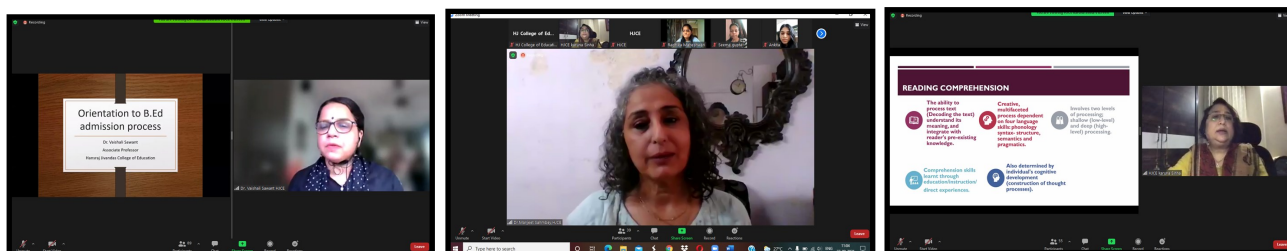
